YEAR-ROUND MOUNTAIN COASTER REGULATIONS



Regulations

- 1. Every user uses the coaster at their own risk.
- 2. The user must adjust the speed so as not to endanger themselves or others.
- 3. Keep a distance of 25 m from the rider in front.
- 4. The user riding down is liable if they run into the car that precedes them.
- 5. The coaster may be used by children over 3 years old. Children under 8 years old may only use the coaster with people who are at least 18 years old and they may only ride down in front of the person who is steering the car. Children over 8 years old (at least 135 cm in height) may ride down on their own after learning the rules of use of the coaster and obtaining permission from their parents or guardians to use the car.
- 6. Maximum load of the car: up to 150 kg.
- 7. During rain and glaze, the staff decides whether to run the coaster.
- 8. It is forbidden for persons under the influence of alcohol or other drugs to use the coaster,
- 9. Alcohol and other intoxicants, as well as smoking, are prohibited on the coaster.
- 10. The coaster user is required to observe the track so that in an emergency situation they can safely reduce speed or stop and immediately notify the staff of any accident on the coaster.
- 11. The user is liable for any damage caused by them during the use of the coaster or as a result of the use of the coaster for culpable and non-culpable reasons or to the occurrence of which they contributed both for damage to property and personal injury.
- 12. In particular, the user is liable for any damage, destruction or reduction of the use value of the equipment, caused by them for culpable and non-culpable reasons, or to which they have contributed, especially those caused by their incompetent use of the equipment.
- 13. Follow the recommendations of the coaster staff.
- 14. The coaster staff have the right to prohibit the use of the coaster to anyone who rides in an unsafe manner or ignores instructions.
- 15. The hotel provides users of the coaster with a full or partial refund of the ticket fee only in the event of an interruption in the coaster's operation of more than three hours.
- 16. The purchase of an admission card is tantamount to acceptance and familiarisation with these regulations.
- 17. Persons who do not comply with the provisions of these regulations and do not follow the instructions of the coaster staff will be obliged to leave the coaster immediately without the right to any refund, in particular the cost of the entrance ticket.
- 18. Any accidents must be reported immediately to service staff.

RULES FOR SAFE RIDING

WHEN RIDING UP

- 1. Every user should wear proper attire and be sober.
- 2. Maintain a seated position when riding, even if the car is stopped.
- 3. At the end of riding up, each car unhooks from the rope automatically.
- 4. Follow the instructions of the coaster staff.
- 5. You can only begin and end the riding in areas designated for this purpose.

WHEN RIDING DOWN

- 1. The larger person always sits in the back, hands should rest on the brake levers.
- 2. Take note of loose clothing and hats. Umbrellas, sticks, and sharp or loose objects are not allowed in the car.
- 3. Adjust your speed according to the weather conditions and your skills.
- 4. When riding, sit facing forward and do not turn around. The slope itself must not be touched.
- 5. Smoking, talking on the phone, and taking pictures along the route are prohibited.
- 6. Do not stop while riding unless it is absolutely necessary.
- 7. Do not ride down too slowly.
- 8. Observe the track in front of you and warning signs, and lean into corners.
- 9. It is not allowed to collide and invade other cars.
- 10. Maintain a minimum distance of 25 m from the preceding car.
- 11. On a wet track, ride slower and keep a larger distance between car (at least 50 m)
- 12. You may use the mountain coaster only when wearing seat belts on all its sections.
- 13. Brake at the end of the route; reduce speed to a minimum before entering the braking belt.
